Dear Ms. Buri:

On November 1, 2012, I visited Sylvan Prairie Park at 8601 Brint Road, Sylvania Township (photos taken) as part of the Restoring Streams in Lucas County workshop sponsored by The Olander Park System, TMACOG, and Partners for Clean Streams. The stream restoration project currently has coverage under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity. You were present to provide information on the project. Ohio EPA has no record of other permittees for this project.

At the time of the inspection, no earthwork was occurring. A portion of Smith Ditch had been widened. The banks had been stabilized with matting and there were plans to seed the surrounding ground that had been disturbed during construction. The project appeared to be in compliance. As construction activities conclude, please remember the permit requirements to apply cover on bare soil in any areas that will sit idle for more than 21 days, such as stockpiles and spoil sites, or that have reached final grade. For areas within 50 feet of a surface water, cover is to be applied within two days.
