**Re: Notice of Violation
G-Cor Automotive Corporation / Franklin County
Industrial Storm Water Permit 4GR00348*EG**

Dear Mr. Greenblott:

This letter is written in regard to the storm water inspection that I conducted on December 4, 2012, at G-Cor Automotive Corporation, located at 2100 Refugee Road, in Columbus, Ohio. The inspection was conducted to determine compliance with your industrial storm water permit. Your company recycles automotive parts from vehicles. Please consider this a formal notice of violation. The following items were noted during the inspection (also, please see attached pictures):

1. There were full and partially full drums, buckets and other waste containers stored outside. Waste containers for solid waste should have a cover. Waste containers for liquid waste should have a cover, be stored in secondary containment and under roof. Some containers were spilling waste material on to the ground. Empty containers should be stored upright with a lid.
2. There were used oil and greasy automobile parts and radiators stored outside. These parts should be stored in a contained area under roof.
3. There appeared to be a new storm water drain installed on the eastside of the building, under an overhang. Since this storm water drain is under roof, please state if the drain goes to a storm water drain or a sanitary drain. Please be aware that only storm water should go to storm water drains and domestic wastewater should only go to the sanitary sewer, unless permission is given by the City of Columbus.



