Dear Mr. Blessing:

On Tuesday, November 27, 2012, I inspected the site at which Northmont's Early Childhood Learning Center in Clayton will be built, to determine compliance with its construction site storm water discharge permit.

Based on my observations, the site appeared to be in substantial compliance with the terms of its permit.

Because no one was present at the site at the time of the inspection, compliance with other permit requirements could not be assessed. Please provide the following information:

1. A copy of the site's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3). (If a true SWP3 is not available, send only the relevant parts of the rolled construction drawings);
2. Information that explains how the developed site will meet post-construction "Water Quality Volume" requirements, as explained in the permit beginning on page 20;
3. The name of the co-permittee for the project;
4. Copies of documented weekly inspections of the site's erosion and sediment controls for the month of November, 2012. The inspections are required until construction has been completed and all bare ground has been stabilized.
