Dear Mr. Waddell:

On November 21, 2012, I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection at Big Bear Lake Family Resort located in Lucasville, Ohio. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Big Bear's compliance with NPDES Permit Number 0GV00030\*AG and the Ohio Water Pollution Control Act, Revised Code Chapter 6111.

As a result of the inspection and review of our files, I have the following comments:


Part II, E of your permit titled, *Renotification for Permit Renewal*, states: In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the date of expiration of the general permit (i.e. renew existing general permit), the permittee shall notify the Director of its intent to be covered by general permit OHS000004 (submit a new NOI) within 45 days after the effective date of that renewed general permit.

**The General Permit is expired and has not been renewed. Discharging without a valid permit is a violation of Ohio Revised Code 6111. If you plan on discharging from this facility in the future, a current permit is required. As long as your permit remains active, you are required to sample and report those results to the Ohio EPA. I spoke with your operator, Rick Hardin, on December 3, 2012. He plans on submitting the NOI for renewal to the Ohio EPA. I informed him to send me a copy of the completed NOI for our records.**

The Ohio EPA strongly encourages pollution prevention as the preferred approach for waste management. The first priority of pollution prevention is to eliminate the generation of wastes and pollutants at the source (source reduction). For those wastes or pollutants that are generated, the second priority is to recycle or reuse them in an

environmentally sound manner. You can benefit economically, help preserve the environment, and improve your public image by implementing pollution prevention programs. 
