Dear Ms Boudinot:

This letter is written regarding my storm water inspections conducted at Resinoid Engineering Corporation located at 2040 James Parkway in Heath, Ohio on December 20, 2012. It is my understanding; you have submitted and obtained a No-Exposure Exemption for this facility as you claim there are no activities or exposed materials, which pose a threat to storm water. This inspection was conducted to ensure your NOE is valid.

Based on my observations, I noted the following issues which may invalidate your NOE:

Site observations:

- I noted a small hose entering the storm sewer associated with the loading dock on the northern end of the building. Please address the origin of the hose and the associated discharge in a response to my attention within three days from receipt of this letter (email preferred).
- An apparent bag house was noted on the western side of the building. Please ensure the bag house is managed in such a manner not to result in a threat to storm water contamination. Good housekeeping practice and routine inspections should be implemented for this area.
