RE: Montgomery County, Dominion Ministries International, Notice of Violation

Dear Pastor Moxley:

We have spoken on several occasions regarding the compliance schedule within the NPDES permit for Dominion Ministries International (NPDES Permit # OH0141062; OEPA Permit # 1PX00071*AD). Permit 1PX00071*AD was issued to Dominion Ministries International on December 14, 2009, and became effective on January 1, 2010. The compliance schedule in permit 1PX00071*AD contains specific milestones and completion dates. In our most recent conversation, you indicated that the funds required to complete the items within the compliance schedule were not available. Dominion Ministries International has violated several requirements of the compliance schedule and they are summarized as follows:

Part 1, C – Schedule of Compliance

- a. *Submit detailed plans for plant and sewer system improvements as soon as possible, but no later than 12 months after the effective date of this permit. (December 31, 2010)*

Dominion Ministries International submitted a Permit to Install (PTI) application for the installation of an on-site sewage treatment and disposal system in November of 2011 (PTI 859790). The PTI application was submitted 23 months after the effective date of the permit. Dominion Ministries International is in violation of the compliance schedule due to the failure to submit the detailed plans within the specified timeframe. Upon reviewing the PTI, it was determined that the proposed installation was for an average discharge of less than 1,000 gallons per day. At that time, you were advised that the proposed installation was under the jurisdiction of Dayton & Montgomery County Public Health. You were asked to contact Dayton & Montgomery County Public Health regarding the proposed installation. It is my understanding that Dominion Ministries International has not obtained approval from Dayton & Montgomery County Public Health for the installation of the on-site sewage treatment and disposal system. In our most recent conversation you stated that Dominion Ministries

International has not obtained the funding required to pursue the installation of the on-site sewage treatment and disposal system.

- b. *Advertise for bids, receive bids, and award contracts as soon as possible, but not later than 15 months after the effective date of this permit. (March 30, 2011)*

It is the understanding of Ohio EPA that this milestone was completed on July 6, 2011. The milestone was completed 18 months after the effective date of the permit. Dominion Ministries International is in violation of the compliance schedule for failing to complete the milestone within the specified timeframe.

- c. *Commence construction as soon as possible, but not later than 24 months after the effective date of this permit. (December 31, 2011)*

As of the date of this letter, Dominion Ministries International has not commenced construction as required. Dominion Ministries International is in violation of the compliance schedule for failing to commence construction within the specified timeframe.

- d. *Notify the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office within seven days of construction initiation.*

Due to the construction not being initiated, Dominion Ministries International is not able to complete this milestone.

- e. *Complete construction as soon as possible, but not later than 30 months after the effective date of this permit. (June 30, 2012)*

Dominion Ministries International has not completed construction as required. Dominion Ministries International is in violation of the compliance schedule for failing to complete construction within the specified timeframe.

- j. *Submit written status reports to the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office every 3 months beginning 6 months after the effective date of this permit.*

I have contacted you periodically to request updates on the progress of the installation and I have documented said contacts. The last conversation we had regarding the status was in June of 2012, and at that time you indicated that Dominion Ministries International continued to explore options for obtaining the finances required to complete the milestones. Dominion Ministries International has not submitted written reports as required and communication regarding the status for the completion of the milestones has been initiated by Ohio EPA. Dominion Ministries International is in violation of the compliance schedule for failure to submit status reports as required.


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Please inform this office, in writing, within ten days of receipt of this notification as to the reason for the above referenced violations, as well as a description of the actions taken or proposed to prevent further violations.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations, monitoring, or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that the additional monitoring requirements within permit 1PX00071*AD become effective July 1, 2012. I encourage you to review Part 1, A "Final Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements" within permit 1PX00071*AD for details concerning the monitoring requirements.
