Dear Ms. Trackler:

This letter is written in follow up to our on-site post-construction storm water inspection at Northpointe. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate the site to determine permit termination eligibility for this site. This permit is currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit associated with Construction Activities within the Olentangy Watershed. The following items were agreed upon during the onsite meeting:

- A Notice of Termination (NOT) may be submitted for this site. The NOT form and filing instructions can be found at: <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dsw/storm/stormform.aspx>.
- Please continue to implement measures to established stream bank stabilization in accordance with the criteria in your approved plan. During the meeting I agreed to clean out of all invasive vegetation during the winter months in order to establish a native cover this upcoming growing season (Spring 2013). Please ensure this agreement is not in conflict with any permit requirements inclusive in the Army Corps of Engineer's Permit.
- I suggest contacting Jeff Watts with Metro Parks for possible assistance with a native seed mixture to meet your needs. (**John Watts**, Resource Manager, HQ [watts@metroparks.net](mailto:watts@metroparks.net), 614-895-6239)
