This letter is written in regard to the storm water inspection that I conducted at Coca-Cola North America, located at 2455 Watkins Road, in Columbus, Ohio. The inspection was conducted on February 5, 2013, to determine compliance with your industrial storm water no exposure permit. I was escorted around your facility by Mr. Ian McCormack. Your company produces beverages. I did not note any discharges from your facility to a storm water drain or waters of the state. Overall, the facility was very well-kept. There were no chemicals, raw materials or final product stored outside that could cause a discharge due to a rain event or snowfall. You have a current No Exposure Certification. I noted the following at your facility:

Dumpsters and trash containers were kept under roof.

Loading and unloading areas for trucks and railcars are done under roof.

Spill kits were located through-out the site.

There was no staining on the pavement.

The facility was well kept and maintained. No trash was noted on the ground.
