Dear Mr. Feldmann:

This letter is written in regard to the storm water inspection that I conducted on September 21, 2012, at Horton Emergency Vehicles located at 2200 Southwest Boulevard, in Grove City, Ohio. The purpose of the follow-up inspection was to verify your No-Exposure Exemption (NOE) in accordance with Ohio EPA's Storm Water Program. Based on my observations, I noted the following during my inspection:

There was a trash container at the site. The lids were closed on the trash container. All trash containers must have their lids closed when not in use. It is recommended to post a sign on the trash container reminding employees to keep the lids closed when not in use.

There were no leaking vehicles parked outside. It appears that previous stains were power-washed.

Please locate spill kits near the garage doors and instruct employees to use them on any spills.
