Dear Mr. Mallow:

This letter is written in regard to a meeting and an industrial storm water inspection that was conducted on September 14, 2012, at Sugar Creek Packing Company, located at 2101 Kenskill Avenue, in Washington Court House, Ohio. The agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. The following items were discussed at the meeting during the site inspection:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

1. There was active construction at the site. The erosion controls were installed at the site, such as dandy bag covers. Please maintain erosion controls and inspect weekly or after a significant rain event (greater than 1 inch).
2. A riser was installed on the effluent discharge of the storm water pond outlet. Please grout the riser to the storm water pond effluent discharge. Please be aware that the riser will be removed after construction.
3. It was agreed to use a concrete trough for low flow events and to install an under-drain system in the storm water pond for higher flow events. The storm water pond would be covered with vegetation and mowed. Please revise the storm water pollution prevention plan to reflect the proposed changes.
