Dear Mr. Perry:

This letter reflects the MS4 inspection I conducted at the Reynoldsburg Maintenance Facility located off of Main Street, Reynoldsburg, Ohio on August 6, 2012. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate storm water management controls specific to salt storage at this facility.

During the inspection I noted recent upgrade to the salt storage facility at this site. It I noted the new covered salt storage facility at this site. This building appears to provide ample protection for any exposure associated with salt storage at this site.

All salt handling and mixing should be conducted under roof to minimize the potential threat of contaminated storm water runoff. Good house keeping practices must be implemented to address any spillage associated with the loading and unloading process.
