Dear Mr. Manning:

This letter is written in follow up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Loch Lomond Estates located off State Route 315 in Delaware County on March 21, 2013. The purpose of the inspection was in response to a complaint I received regarding clearing activities of a stream near the entrance of the site.

During the inspection, I noted the clearing activities associated with the stream near the entrance of the site (see attached photo). As a result I spoke with the property manager Sue Kayser. Miss Kayser indicated there would be stabilization effort implemented by the end of March 2013.

Miss Kayser further indicated there may be intentions to culvert this stream. Please understand any fill placement within this stream which includes culvert installation requires specific permits issue by Army Corps of Engineers and Ohio EPA. It is imperative you contact us prior to any culvert installation to ensure all appropriate permit and possible mitigation are addressed.
