**Re: Storm Water Inspection at Earhart Petroleum Inc. / Franklin County
Permit #: 4GR00346*EG**

Dear Mr. Earhart,

This letter is written in follow-up to an industrial storm water inspection I conducted, at Earhart Petroleum Inc. located at 7810 East Main Street, Reynoldsburg, Ohio on August 6, 2012. I understand this facility is currently covered under the Multi Sector General Permit (MSGP) issued by Ohio EPA. Based on my inspection and the requirements of the General Permit the following items were noted:

Storm water management:

- It has been brought to my attention that this facility is currently looking to modify and upgrade the existing storm water controls associated with storage and handling of all petroleum products. Please note I have made several written requests with respect to the time frames necessary to complete the afore mentioned upgrades. Failure to upgrade the storm water management controls does result in violation of your storm water permit.
- Site observations noted failure of the secondary containment measure associated with the large storage tanks at this facility. In addition the unloading area fails to meet the intent of the permit. The upgrades must include the replacement of the secondary containment structure as well as the unloading pad. These upgrades must be completed within six(6) months from receipt of this letter otherwise escalated enforcement will follow.

At this time I am asking for a formal written response to the action items addressed in this letter. Be sure to address the necessary time frames to complete the upgrades at this facility.
