Dear Ms. Hovermale:

On October 31, 2012, NPDES permit number 0GH00020\*AG expired and any discharge from the State Route 538 gas line replacement project is unpermitted. Unauthorized discharges are in violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 6111.04 and subject you to significant monetary penalties. If you would like to continue coverage under the NPDES permit please submit a Notice of Intent form and fee to our Central Office. If the project is complete and the permit is no longer needed please submit a Notice of Termination form to our Central Office.

We have used our Surface Water Information Management System (SWIMS) to review your self-monitoring reports covering the months of January 2013 through March 2013 and found the February 2013 monitoring report was submitted after the deadline. The failure to submit monthly discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) according to the terms and conditions of your permit is a violation to your discharge permit.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit will result in enforcement action pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
