**RE: New Kroger Grocery Store, Fuel Center and Additional Retail Buildings; NPDES Permit # 1GC04210\*AG; Construction Site Inspection**

Dear Mr. Smollen:

On Thursday, May 30, 2013, I inspected the New Kroger Grocery Store, Fuel Center and Additional Retail Buildings project located at SR 125 & Amelia-Olive Branch Road in Amelia, Ohio, to determine compliance with its NPDES construction site storm water discharge permit. I walked the property, but did not meet with anyone while at the site.

Based on my observations, there were no obvious violations of the project's storm water discharge permit. I did not review sediment control inspection logs or the site's storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3).

As a reminder, please note that when construction is complete, and all areas of the site have been permanently stabilized with vegetation or other ground cover, the construction permit must be terminated.
