Dear Mr. Clay:

This letter is written in regard to the storm water inspection that I conducted on June 3, 2013, at Crete Carrier Corporation Terminal #243, located at 5400 Crosswind Drive, Columbus, Ohio. The inspection was conducted to determine compliance with your industrial storm water permit. Your facility is a trucking and distribution company and I was accompanied on the inspection by Eddie Beavers, shop manager. Overall, the facility is well maintained and you are compliant with your storm water permit. The following items were noted during the inspection:

1. The truck parking area drains to an oil-water separator. Safety Kleen pumps out the oil-water separator on a semi-annual schedule.
2. The fueling station was located under roof and included a spill kit and an emergency contact list. The fueling station had an emergency shut-off switch.
3. The dumpsters were covered.
4. There was very little oil staining on the pavement at your facility.
5. The inspections were conducted per your storm water pollution prevention plan. Sampling is conducted from storm water basin #8.
