Dear Mr. McCracken:

On May 29, 2013, I visited the sites located on Twp. Rd. 1161 and Co. Rd. 38 that have construction storm water permits with the Ohio EPA. The purpose of my inspection was to determine the compliance of these sites with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for discharges of storm water associated with construction activity. The inspections were conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

No violations of the terms and conditions of the permit were discovered. Please continue to implement permit requirements as construction continues.

As a reminder, if your project disturbs more than five acres you are required to implement post construction water quality volume storage requirements with permanent storm water management structures as required by the permit.
