Dear Mr. Brunk and Mr. Hurd:

On Tuesday, June 25, 2013, James Schwieterman and I inspected the Existing Pond for City of Mason construction site located at 305 Lakeview Drive in Mason, Ohio, to determine compliance with its NPDES construction site storm water discharge permit. I walked the property and met with Steve Caddell.

Based on my observations, there were no obvious violations of the project's storm water discharge permit. I did not review sediment control inspection logs, or the site's storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3).

As a reminder, please note that when construction is complete, and all areas of the site have been permanently stabilized with vegetation or other ground cover, the construction permit must be terminated.
