This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection by Paul Hafner and Sam Marotta of the Ohio EPA, we conducted at Alum Creek Transfer Station located at 2100 Alum Creek Transfer Station on June 19, 2013. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with Ohio EPA's General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, we noted the following:
