Ladies and Gentlemen:

We have reviewed compliance with the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit #OH0021857; Ohio EPA #1PC00011*ID). In Part I Section C of this permit, the dates of three compliance schedule milestones are overdue. The overdue milestones relate to Item 2 – Effluent Flow Meter Construction of the Schedule of Compliance. The milestones are as follow:

- Submission of an approvable Permit to Install (PTI) for the installation of an effluent flow meter (Event Code 53799) with a scheduled completion date of June 1, 2012.
- Initiating construction of the effluent flow meter approved in the PTI (Event Code 3099) with a scheduled completion date of September 1, 2012.
- Completing construction of the effluent flow meter (Event Code 4599) with a scheduled completion date of December 1, 2012.

Ohio EPA failed to receive any updates prior to the above mentioned completion dates. This is a violation of the NPDES Permit. Please inform this office, in writing, by February 1, 2012, as to the reason(s) for the above referenced violation(s), as well as a description of the action(s) taken to prevent further violation(s).

Finally, please be advised that the failure to comply with the requirements of your NPDES Permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
