On January 26, 2011, Pike Delta York Local Schools received coverage under the Ohio EPA General Permit for Storm Water Associated with Construction Activity (CGP) for the Bus Fueling Station located on the west side of County Road 6-2, Village of Delta, Fulton County. This CGP is still active and Robin Rayfield was named as the contact.

On June 12, 2013, an inspection of this facility showed that this project has been completed. The purpose of this visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the CGP. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

The CGP requires that a Notice of Termination (NOT) be filed to relieve the applicant of the obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of this general permit including regular inspections of this site. I am enclosing an NOT form to terminate this permit.
