Inspection Findings**

Dear Mr. Bush:

On Monday, July 8, 2013, I inspected the Dollar General site in Urbana, Ohio to determine compliance with the site's NPDES construction site storm water discharge permit. I did not speak with anyone at the site.

Based on my observations, there were no obvious violations of the project's storm water discharge permit. I did not review the sediment control inspection logs or the site's storm water pollution prevention plan before my inspection. All the post construction best management practices (BMPs) are working efficiently. The site is no longer under construction and is completely stabilized with grass and pavement.

As a reminder, please note that when construction is complete, and all areas of the site have been permanently stabilized with vegetation or other ground cover, the construction permit must be terminated.
