**RE: Safe Routes to School; NPDES Permit #1GC03842\*AG; Compliance Inspection Findings**

Dear Mr. Hale:

On Tuesday, July 16, 2013, I inspected the Safe Routes to School project in Versailles, Ohio, to determine compliance with the site's NPDES construction site storm water discharge permit. I did not speak with anyone during the inspection.

Based on my observations, there were no obvious violations of the project's storm water discharge permit. I did not review the sediment control inspection logs or the site's storm water pollution prevention plan before my inspection. The project is complete and grass is established.

As a reminder, please note that when construction is complete, and all areas of the site have been permanently stabilized with vegetation or other ground cover, the construction permit must be terminated.
