Dear Mr. Murphy:

This letter is written in response to your letter I received on June 10, 2013, providing me with an update of items that have been completed or will be completed at JD Equipment facilities in London, Washington Court House and Lancaster, Ohio. The report addresses the issues raised in my previous comment letters. Only a few items need further clarification. I have also included below items from the report that were either underway at the time of the report or were identified as actions still needing to be completed.

Requested Information:

1. The report states that the hauling records for the past year for the Lancaster facility were attached. They were not attached. Please forward these records to me at your earliest convenience.
2. The report states that the sludge will be placed on a section of the wash pad for drainage until it is properly dewatered prior to disposal. Please clarify how this dewatered sludge will be disposed of.
3. Please let me know as each of the ongoing and future action items identified below is completed.

Ongoing or Future Action Items Identified in the Report:

1. A cover for the roll-off at the Washington CH facility was being constructed at the time of the report and may already be completed.
2. The quarterly visual outfall sampling and the annual submittal requirement has been implemented for all facilities.
3. A permit to install (PTI) application will be submitted for the Lancaster site for the outside wash pad temporary disposal system. The report states that this PTI application will be submitted within 45 days of June 8, 2013 (July 23, 2013.)
4. A long term solution to disposal of the collected wash water, including potentially connecting to Lancaster, is being investigated. Please continue to communicate with me on this issue.

5. A PTI application will be submitted for the existing underground holding tank.
6. An alarm and proper signage for the existing underground holding tank will be installed.

For your information, Washington Court House has submitted to this office a PTI for a sanitary line to serve the area which includes the Washington Court House JD Equipment facility. The PTI is currently under review.

The comprehensive report you submitted details that you have made significant progress in addressing the issues raised in my previous comment letters. We appreciate your efforts to comply with your industrial storm water.
