NPDES Permit 1GC04361\*AG; Compliance Inspection Findings**

Dear Mr. Dobrzeniecki:

On Thursday, August 1, 2013, I inspected the Speedway Gas Station site in Miamisburg, Ohio to determine compliance with the site's NPDES construction site storm water discharge permit. You were present during the inspection.

Based on my observations, there were no obvious violations of the project's storm water discharge permit. The reason for the inspection was due to a complaint from a concerned citizen. Please monitor the construction entrance to make sure dirt is not being tracked onto the road. Any sediment on the road is capable of being washed into a city's storm sewer system, which is a violation. I did not review the sediment control inspections logs or the site's storm water pollution prevention plan before my inspection, but records of inspections of the erosion control BMPs are required to be kept.

As a reminder, please note that when construction is complete, and all areas of the site have been permanently stabilized with vegetation or other ground cover, the construction permit must be terminated.
