Dear Mr. Meyer:

On July 25, 2013, I performed a compliance inspection for storm water best management practices (BMPs) at the above referenced site. Our records indicate Independence Excavating, Inc. obtained coverage under the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Construction Activities #3GC06441*AG on April 5, 2013.

My inspection of the site revealed the following deficiency in storm water BMPs:

- **Stabilization, i.e., seeding and mulching, has not been initiated on the soil stockpile area as required by the NPDES permit.** Temporary stabilization must be initiated within 7 days of last disturbance on any disturbed area of the site if it will not be further disturbed within 14 days of last disturbance. Permanent stabilization must be initiated within 7 days of reaching final grade.

Please provide me with a letter of response indicating the actions taken to address the deficiency noted herein. Your response should be received **no later than August 23, 2013**. If you have any questions, please contact me via email at molly.drinkuth@epa.ohio.gov or at (330) 963-1215.
