NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Imbrogno:

On August 5, 2013, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection at the Efficient Machine Products Corp facility located at 12133 Alameda Drive. Our inspection's purpose was to determine compliance with the Ohio EPA General Storm Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Industrial Activity #OH000005. The site's industrial activities are categorized by the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 3451: Fabricated Metal Products except Machinery & Transportation Equipment and Coating, Engraving, & Allied Services. This corresponds to Subsector AA1 in Part 8 of the NPDES permit. During the inspection, you represented Efficient Machine Products Corp. I represented the Ohio EPA.

Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)

The facility currently has coverage under the Ohio EPA General NPDES Permit 3GR01240*EG. Our records show that the permit for your facility was issued June 26, 2009. Part 5 of the NPDES Permit requires one to create and implement a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). During the inspection, your facilities' SWPPP was not reviewed. It was brought to my attention at the inspection that Efficient Machine Products Corp received a "No Exposure Certification" as of May 14, 2013. Edward Imbrogno and I still inspected the site and discussed potential problematic areas.

Site Inspection

1. It was suggested to cap the open drain in the old shipping and receiving dock to eliminate it as a possible pollutant.

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2. During the inspection, the company was undergoing a parking lot renovation. It was discussed to put up a curb or berm in the back to protect the creek running behind the building.
3. As a final reminder, be sure to implement good housekeeping practices on the site to eliminate the chance of any pollution leaving the site.

I will not be in the office at the time of your response so please provide a letter of response, no later than **August 28, 2013**, directed to Dan Bogoevski, indicating the actions you will take to address the concerns and violations involving industrial storm water noted above.
