Dear Mr. Reck:

We are in receipt of your self-monitoring reports covering the months of April through June 2013 for the above referenced facilities. Our review indicates a violation of the conditions of your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The specific instance of non-compliance is enclosed on a separate sheet.

We have received Ms. Robin Reck's response letter dated July 22, 2013. Her letter explained the possible reason for the violation, but did not give a timeframe in which the violation would be corrected. **Within 21 days** of the date of this letter, please submit, in writing, the actions that you propose to undertake in order to return your facility to compliance with your NPDES permit. These actions and timetable may also be submitted by email to me at Justin.Williams@epa.ohio.gov.

If we do not receive your timely response or if your response does not adequately address the violations attached to this letter, the Director of Ohio EPA will likely take an enforcement action against you to bring these facilities into compliance with Ohio law.


