Dear Mr. Applegate:

On Tuesday, August 13, 2013, I inspected the City of Union Global Logistics Airpark site in Union, Ohio, to determine compliance with the site's NPDES construction site storm water discharge permit. I briefly spoke with you before the inspection.

Based on my observations, there were no obvious violations of the project's storm water discharge permit. I did not review the sediment control inspection logs or the site's storm water pollution prevention plan before my inspection, but records of inspections of the erosion control BMPs are required to be kept.

Due to the size of this site I would like to analyze the following documents. Please provide within 14 days of receipt of this letter the following information:

1. A copy of the site's storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3);
2. Copies of sediment control inspections kept for the project since the start of the excavation process;
