
On July 23, 2013, Zachary Titkemeier and Tom Wilkins inspected the proposed Dollar General Store at the southwest corner of State Route 65 and Progressive Drive, Columbus Grove (photos taken). The purpose of the visit was to evaluate compliance of the site with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharges associated with construction activity. The inspection was conducted under the provisions of Ohio's water pollution control statutes, Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 6111.

During the inspection, it was apparent that no construction activities had taken place at the site. Tom Wilkins emailed you on July 24, 2013, to inquire about the status of the project. You replied that same day, informing him that the project failed to materialize due to zoning issues. Accordingly, a Notice of Termination (NOT) must be filed to relieve you of the obligation to comply with this general permit. The NOT form and instructions can be found on our website:  
<http://www.epa.ohio.gov/dsw/storm/stormform.aspx>. NOTs must be mailed to Ohio EPA's Central Office.

You also have the option to transfer the permit coverage to another operator. Should you decide to pursue this option, you must do so within 60 days of the transfer of responsibility. Please note that the Construction General Permit has recently been reissued. You will be notified in the near future on how to reapply for permit coverage if you decide to retain or transfer the permit.
