This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection that I conducted on August 26, 2013, at Taco Bell located along London-Groveport Road, in Grove City, Ohio. The construction appears complete. I understand that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following items must be addressed:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

All barren areas were properly stabilized. It appears that the site can apply for a notice of termination to close-out the construction permit. Please see post construction requirements below.

Post Construction Requirements:

The General Permit mandates specific water quality treatment for storm water following the completion of construction (see attachment). Please be able to demonstrate your post construction requirements per the General Permit will be met. Please submit to my attention the water quality calculations demonstrating compliance. This information can be sent to my attention via a response letter, or to my email at greg.sanders@epa.state.oh.us. The calculations should be signed and stamped by a professional engineer.
