Dear Mr. Gray:

This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection I conducted of your facility, Rinker Materials- Columbus Pipe Plane located at 620 Liberty Road in Delaware, Ohio on July 26, 2012.

Please understand this facility was initially covered under Ohio EPA's General Storm Water Permit associated with Industrial Activities. However, your permit has expired based on our current records. At this time I am formally requesting you seek coverage under Ohio EPA's Multisector General Permit for renewal.

Based my storm water inspection in the conditions set forth in the General Permit the following items will require attention:

Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP):

A storm water pollution prevention plan must be developed specific for this site. The SWPPP must identify all outfalls and drainage patterns associated with all industrial activities. The location of all monitoring outfalls must be identified in the SWPPP. The plan must include all Best Management Practices (BMPs) implemented and maintained to ensure compliance with the Multisector General Permit.

Storm Water Management:

During the investigation it appeared that the facility was not in operation. I was unable to identify all storm water management controls as a result. At this time I am formally request a full onsite inspection to determine eligibility requirements and storm water management requirements based on current conditions.
