Dear Mr. Chapin:

A review of the compliance schedule items contained in Part I,C of the Village of New London Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit has been conducted by Ohio EPA. This review indicates that the following projects of the compliance schedule have not yet been completed:

1. Part I, C., Item 1.e.iii – which required the Village to submit an annual status report update on the SSO elimination project to be submitted to Ohio EPA by September 1, 2013.

Ohio EPA records indicate that Permit to Install (PTI) No. 920186 was issued on March 20, 2013, for Sanitary Sewer Replacement in multiple areas of the Village. Please submit the annual status report as soon as possible. Make sure to include an updated construction schedule for the completion of this project as part of the report.

2. Part I, C., Item 2.b. – which required the Village to submit a report indicating how it proposed to meet the phosphorus limit at outfall 001 by September 1, 2011.
3. Part I, C., Item 2.c. – which required the Village to begin construction of any upgrades at the WWTP that are needed to meet the phosphorus limit at outfall 001 by September 1, 2012.

We understand that you are working with Jones and Henry Engineers to design phosphorus treatment components that will be installed at the WWTP to meet the items listed above. However; we need a written status update on these items.

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Within **21** days of the date of this letter, please submit, in writing, the actions that you propose to undertake in order to return your facility into compliance with the compliance schedule contained in your NPDES permit. Please also provide us with a timetable for these actions that does not extend past **August 31, 2014**.
