Mr. Beringer:

On July 24, 2013, an inspection of the above referenced site was conducted by this writer. A representative of the facility was not present during the inspection. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the status of the facility, in addition to the facility's compliance status with respect to the terms and conditions of the above referenced National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

A file review in preparation for the inspection revealed the following items:

1. The facility ceased operations on July 31, 2002.
2. This office has no record of receiving a monthly discharge monitoring report since October 2004.
3. The facility's NPDES permit expired on April 30, 2006.

The July 24th site inspection verified that the facility is no longer in operation and multiple parcels of property have been sold to Mr. Mark Kerchmar. Mr. Kerchmar indicated that he purchased approximately 20 acres of the former Sterling Foundry property. Several of the former Sterling Foundry buildings are being used for storage buildings. Mr. Kerchmar is also in the process of dismantling the former foundry building and salvaging the metals for scrap value. However, it was observed that the foundry sand generated from the former Sterling Foundry facility was still present in the permitted landfill area. The last correspondence from the office dated July 29, 2011, required the following forms to be submitted to this office no later than September 30, 2011:

- A. Application forms 1 and 2F
- B. Antidegradation Addendum

To date, this office has no record of receiving these forms. Therefore, you are being referred to the Legal Section of our Central Office for enforcement. A staff attorney will contact you in the near future.
