Dear Mr. Vaughn:

On October 15, 2012, this office issued a Non HPV Notice of Violation (NOV) letter to Hocking Valley Concrete regarding the failure to obtain a permit-to-install and operate (PTIO) prior to installation or modification, and subsequent operation of any new source at the new facility address of 1500 Commerce Drive in New Lexington, Ohio. As part of the NOV, we requested that you submit a compliance plan and schedule that details the company's strategy and timeline to submit the requested PTIO applications for the emissions units that are currently operating at this new site.

On October 31, 2012, you submitted an email detailing that you had met with Ralph Witte of Ohio EPA, OCAAP and would be submitting new PTIO applications within the next month. On December 10, 2012, and December 17, 2012, Hocking Valley Concrete submitted the required PTIO applications. Based upon my review of your response to the October 15, 2012, NOV letter, Hocking Valley Concrete has returned to compliance for the cited violations.

With the corrective actions taken to bring the source(s) into compliance, as indicated above, the referenced violations are considered resolved. Please note, however, that this does not preclude Ohio EPA's authority from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
