Dear Mr. Prouty:

On January 25, 2012, this office issued a Non HPV Notice of Violation (NOV) letter to Sidwell Materials-Cedar Rapids Horizontal Screen and Sidwell Materials-Irock 150 RDS Crushing regarding the failure to obtain prior approval before relocating a portable source and excessive fugitive dust emissions coming from the portable sources. As part of the NOV, we requested that you submit a compliance plan and schedule to return the facility to compliance within 30 days.

On June 14, 2012, you submitted the requested plan and schedule. Please note that you failed to submit your response within the requested 30-day timeframe. In your response, you stated that you have examined Sidwell's internal processes and provided additional training to employees to prevent violations from occurring in the future.

Based upon my review of your response to the January 25, 2012, NOV, Sidwell Materials-Cedar Rapids Horizontal Screen and Sidwell Materials-Irock 150 RDS Crushing has resolved the cited violations. We will now proceed with processing the Intent to Relocate forms that you submitted for both companies.
