**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS
LETTER OF WARNING FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Hall:

On May 14, 2013, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Hall Brothers Inc. located at 27040 Cook Road in Olmsted Township.

On May 31, 2013, CDAQ issued a Letter of Warning requiring Hall Brothers Inc. to submit a corrective action plan in respect to monitoring and recordkeeping deficiencies found during CDAQ's inspection regarding the operation of emissions unit (EU) N001: Incinerator. Additionally, CDAQ requested the submittal of the following records, as required by EU N001's Permit-to-Install/Operate (PTIO):

- Written record of temperatures and duration of combustion each time EU N001 is in operation.
- Amounts and type of material charged each time.
- Log of daily operations of the EU N001, including time and date the ash is removed.
- When the weather conditions allow, perform checks for any visible emissions from the stack during operation of EU N001.

CDAQ is in receipt of the applicable records, and a corrective action plan as of June 11, 2013. The corrective action plan was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring EU N001 into compliance. Also, Hall Brothers Inc. partners, Mr. Gerald Hall and Mr. Richard Hall, both communicated to CDAQ that they will pay more attention to filling out Ohio EPA's Annual Permit Evaluation Report (PER) correctly. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
