Dear Mr. Daugherty:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued one or more permit(s)-to-install and operate (PTIO) for the facility identified above. The terms and conditions in the PTIO require the submission of reports for each emissions unit contained in the permit. The purpose of these report(s) is to evaluate compliance with terms and conditions of the facility's PTIO.

Below is a summary of the findings, violations, and action items that need to be addressed:

Finding 1: Failure to submit compliance reports

A review of CDO's records established that the following compliance reports were not submitted in accordance with the indicated sections of Atlas's permits.

Violation

Failure to submit timely reports is a violation of the terms and conditions of PTIO P0109620. Violations of the terms and conditions of an effective permit are also considered violations of ORC 3704.05(C).

Requested Action

Ohio EPA requests that the facility submit all above mentioned reports and all future reports in accordance with the terms and conditions of PTIO P0109620 Section e)(1). The reports shall be submitted within 30 days of receipt of this letter.

The facility is a Synthetic Minor Title V (SMTV) facility and is required to submit permit applications and reports via the eBusiness Center: Air Services, which is accessed through the eBusiness Center. The eBusiness Center may be reached from the Ohio EPA home page at <http://www.epa.ohio.gov> or directly at <http://ohio.epa.ohio.gov>. If you need assistance with Air Services, contact Elisa Thomas at (614) 644-3821.

Please note that Ohio EPA has the authority to seek civil penalties as provided in the ORC Section 3704.06. Submittal of the above requested information, including records and reports, does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in the ORC Section 3704.06. The determination to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by Ohio EPA at a later date.
