**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. So:

On March 20, 2013, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Ledgewood Cleaners located at 17100 Royalton Road in Strongsville.

On April 1, 2013, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation requiring Ledgewood Cleaners to submitting the following six (6) items:

- A Permit To Install and Operate (PTIO) and Emissions Activity Category (EAC) form for Emissions Unit (EU) D001: Forenta D-235 Dry-To-Dry Dry Cleaning Machine;
- Copies of the invoices for the gaskets and/or replacement equipment for the four (4) leaking components (main door hatch, still door, primary lint filter and button trap) and the date on which repairs/installations occur;
- A copy of the halogenated hydrocarbon detector purchase invoice;
- A copy of a sample of the monthly perchloroethylene (PERC) usage as well as rolling 12-month PERC usage totals;
- A copy of the weekly recording of the exhaust gas temperature on the outlet of the refrigerated condenser; and
- A copy of the weekly recording of perceptible leak checks.

On May 6, 2013, CDAQ received a time extension request and issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan letter dated May 6, 2013, giving Ledgewood Cleaners until June 14, 2013, to submit the six (6) items requested above.



On May 16, 2013, CDAQ received A PTIO and EAC form for EU D001: Forenta D-235 Dry-To-Dry Dry Cleaning Machine.

On June 17, 2013, CDAQ received a time extension request and issued a Second Receipt of Corrective Action Plan letter dated June 18, 2013, giving Ledgewood Cleaners until June 28, 2013, to submit the six (6) items requested above.

CDAQ is in receipt of the remaining five (5) items requested above dated July 1, 2013.

The corrective action plan was received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
