Dear Robert Long:

This is in follow-up to my facility inspection on September 10, 2013 and email correspondence received September 16, 2013, and is intended to summarize my findings regarding the general compliance status of your facility with applicable air pollution control requirements. I would like to thank you for your cooperation during my visit.

I must advise you that Robeck Fluid Power Co. has been operating emissions unit K001 in violation of Permit to Install and Operate (PTIO) P0112548, Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-21-09(U)(2)(e)(ii), and OAC rule 3745-21-09(B)(3)(e).

The PTIO and OAC rule 3745-21-09 require the permittee to employ no more than three gallons of coatings in any one day when coating metal parts for emissions unit K001. From the records provided for 2011 to present, emissions unit K001 employed more than three gallons of coatings when coating metal parts on the following dates: 2/18/11, 3/9/11, 3/28/11, 3/29/11, 4/5/11, 4/13/11, 4/28/11, 7/27/11, 8/26/11, 9/29/11, 9/30/11, 12/19/11, 1/19/12, 1/20/12, 4/5/12, 11/15/12, 2/12/13, 2/13/13, 3/3/13, 3/4/13, 3/14/13, 3/15/13, 5/22/13, and 5/23/13. This constitutes a violation of OAC rule 3745-21-09(U)(2)(e)(ii) and Emissions Unit Term and Condition C.1.c)(1) of PTIO P0112548.

The PTIO and OAC rule 3745-21-09 require the permittee to notify the director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) in writing of any daily record showing that the coating line employs more than the applicable maximum daily coating usage limit. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days after the exceedance occurs. To date no notifications have been submitted for the exceedances of the applicable maximum daily coating usage limit for emission unit K001. This constitutes a violation of OAC rule 3745-21-09(B)(3)(e) and Emissions Unit Term and Condition c.1.e)(1) of PTIO P0112548. Please submit the required notification for all past exceedances within 30 days receipt of this letter.

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Please submit to this office, within 30 days of receipt of this letter, a plan and schedule for achieving compliance. Submit this plan to the attention of Megan Talcott.

This letter or information pursuant to this letter does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will determine later whether to pursue such penalties in this case.
