Dear Permit Holder,

The purpose of this letter is to bring to your attention that New Castle Refractories Company failed to submit a compliance certification for the reporting year **[report year]** by April 30 in violation of OAC rule 3745-77-07(B)(5), the terms and conditions of your Title V Permit, and Revised Code (RC) Section 3704.05(C). It is important that your company immediately prepare and submit this required compliance certification, as soon as possible, but not later than 30 days from receipt of this letter. If you fail to submit the Title V Compliance Certification by the deadline, we will submit an enforcement action request to the central office of Ohio EPA. Appropriate enforcement action will be taken which will likely include the assessment of civil penalties. The submission of this compliance certification does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in RC Chapter 3704.

All owners/operators of facilities which were subject to a final issued Title V permit-to-operate during the reporting year must submit a Title V Compliance Certification. The information in this letter is designed to help you know:

- **The regulatory basis for the compliance certification.**
- **The reporting period for this requirement.**
- **The compliance certification must be submitted via the eBusiness Center: Air Services.**
- **A hard copy of the compliance certification must be sent to U.S. EPA.**

The regulatory basis for the compliance certification

You are required to submit a Compliance Certification if your company had a final Title V permit become effective on or prior to December 31 of the reporting year. This is required per Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-77-07(C)(5).

The reporting period for this requirement

The reporting period is from January 1 to December 31. If the initial Title V permit for the facility was issued during the reporting year then the reporting period would be from the effective date of the Title V permit through December 31. If the facility permanently shut down all operations, or had the Title V permit expire and is no longer subject to OAC Chapter 3745-77, then the reporting period would be from January 1 to the date either of those events occurred. If the permit was modified during the calendar year, the certifications must reflect certification of the permit terms and conditions as applicable pre and post permit modification respectively.

The compliance certification must be submitted via the eBusiness Center: Air Services

The compliance certification must be submitted via the eBusiness Center: Air Services. You can get assistance with Air Services from the following sources:

- **Web page-specific online help within Air Services**
- **Electronic mailing list for Air Services users** - All established Air Services accounts will be signed up automatically to receive updates to Air Services-related topics (you will have the option to “opt-out” if you wish).
- **Searchable frequently asked questions and fast responses to new questions** - DAPC is taking advantage of the Agency “Answer Place” to post topics, videos, and links to guidance in navigating and using the eBusiness Center and Air Services. We strongly encourage you to visit the Answer Place and sign up to receive updates to Air Services-related topics if you are not currently an Air Services user.
- **Training Videos** - We have posted video training sessions on the Answer Place to help you through processes such as getting an account on the eBusiness Center and gaining access to your facility. We currently have videos posted on developing your facility profile, compliance reporting, and more.
