Dear Jay Vigneault:

The purpose of this letter is to bring to your attention that Ameri-Cal failed to submit a quarterly deviation (excursion) report for the third quarter reporting period of 2011 (covering July to September 2011) by October 31 in violation of OAC rule 3745-15-03(B)(1)(b) and 3745-15-03(C), the terms and conditions of your Federally Enforceable Permit to Install and Operate (FEPTIO) (see e)(1) page 17 of 22), and Revised Code (RC) Section 3704.05(C).

It is important that your company immediately prepare and submit this required deviation report, as soon as possible, but not later than 14 days from receipt of this letter. If you fail to submit the deviation report by the deadline, we will submit an enforcement action request to the central office of Ohio EPA. Appropriate enforcement action will be taken which will likely include assessment of civil penalties. The submission of this deviation report does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in RC Chapter 3704.

Unless other arrangements have been approved by the Director, all reports shall be submitted through Ohio EPA's eBusiness Center: Air Services online web portal.
