RE: NOTICE OF VIOLATION OF OAC RULE 3745-21-09 (DDD)

Dear Mr. Hamdan:

Your Gas Dispensing Facility (GDF) is in violation of **OAC rule 3745-21-09 (DDD)(2), which specifies Stage II testing requirements and its frequency**. This facility was scheduled for testing on or before **August 9th, 2011**. Your Stage II testing was not completed until **November 7th, 2011**.

Our Agency is in receipt of the November 7th, 2011, Stage II test results submitted by Environmental Compliance Technologies (ECT) for Marathon on the Square gasoline dispensing facility located at 143 Board Street, located in Wadsworth.

Upon review, the test results are accepted as received and will be included in the operating file for this facility. However, acceptance of the information requested by this Agency does not constitute a waiver of this Agency's or the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. This Agency has the option to reject or accept late submittals. The determination to pursue or decline such penalties will be made at a later date.

This facility will be inspected on an annual basis for compliance with the Stage II vapor recovery rule. It is required that you keep record keeping information at a readily available location for inspection. For this Agency, it is requested that you keep copies of the required information at each individual location where all employees can access them.

Full compliance testing, as conducted at this facility, must be performed again within five year intervals according to the testing requirements of OAC rule 3745-21-09 (DDD)(2)(a)&(b). This facility will be due for **full testing** on or before **August 9th, 2015**. Notification of testing is required as before, as well as reporting requirements.
