

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

has violated the following environmental laws, orders, rules, or regulations on the indicated dates at the above address.

ORC 3704.05 Prohibited act.
(C) No person who is the holder of a permit issued under division (F) or (G) of section 3704.03 of the Revised Code shall violate any of its terms or conditions.

OAC rule 3745-31-05(D) - The director may impose such special terms and conditions as are appropriate or necessary to ensure compliance with the applicable laws and to ensure adequate protection of environmental quality.

Hale Chrome Services, Inc. failed to perform the required emission testing for P002-P003, P008, and P011-P015 within 6 months of permit issuance. Permits were issued on February 12, 2008 and testing was required by August 12, 2008.

The above violation(s) may subject the violator to penalties of up to \$25,000 per violation. It is possible that a penalty may be assessed in this case. If a penalty is to be assessed, the amount will be determined after your response is reviewed.
