

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The City of Toledo Division of Environmental Services (TDOES) hereby serves notice that:

has violated the following environmental laws, orders, rules, or regulations on the indicated date at the above address.

<p>40 CFR Part 63.322(k) and 63.324(d)(3); 40 CFR Part 63.323(a)(1)(ii) and 63.324(d)(5); Permit to Operate (PTO), terms Part II., section C. 1., C.2. and C.3.. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements</p> <p>The permittee shall maintain a log of the results of all visual inspections, the dates of repair and records of written or verbal orders for repair parts, and the recordkeeping as required by term C.3. of the PTO.</p>	<p>On February 24, 2009 during a facility inspection the operator at this facility did not keep a log of the required weekly visual inspections and repair program of the dry cleaning equipment.</p> <p>On February 24, 2009 during a facility inspection the operator at this facility did not monitor the temperature of the air-perchloroethylene gas-vapor stream on the outlet side of the refrigerated condenser weekly.</p> <p>On February 24, 2009 during a facility inspection the operator at this facility did not keep a log of the pounds of fabric dry cleaned with perchloroethylene and other records as required by term C.3. of the PTO.</p>
<p>40 CFR 63.322(o)</p> <p>Once a month, the permittee is to conduct the inspections of the dry cleaning equipment using a halogenated detector or PCE gas analyzer.</p>	<p>On February 24, 2009 during a facility inspection the operator at this facility did not keep a log of the halogen leak detector monthly checks of the dry cleaning equipment.</p>

The above violation(s) may subject the violator to **penalties** of up to \$25,000 per violation. It is possible that a penalty will be assessed in this case. If a penalty is to be assessed, the amount will be determined after your response is reviewed

Required Actions

Within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this Notice of Violation, the permittee shall:

1. Abate the violations or provide for an acceptable remedy.
2. Reply in writing to this Notice of Violation within fourteen (14) days of receipt. The reply shall include:
 - a. descriptions and dates of actions taken thus far to abate the violation(s);
 - b. descriptions and expeditious time schedule of actions yet to be taken to remedy the violation(s); and
 - c. descriptions of actions taken or to be taken to prevent recurrence of the violation(s).

Recommended Remedial Actions

It is recommended that you consider the following suggestions:

- Implement all monitoring, recordkeeping, reporting and testing requirements of the Permit to Operate at Lincoln Cleaners, Inc..
- Implement the additional requirements of the amended MACT, 40 CFR 63, subpart M, in particular Part 63.322(o).
- Use the halogenated hydrocarbon detector at least once a month and count as one of the weekly visual inspections.
