NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The City of Toledo Division of Environmental Services (TDOES) hereby serves notice that:

has violated the following environmental laws, orders, rules, or regulations on the indicated date at the above address.

<b>Regulations Violated</b>	<b>Description of Violations</b>
40 CFR Part 63.322(o) and PTIO, terms C., section 1., d., (4), d. Monitoring and/or Recordkeeping Requirements  (4)d. Records shall be kept of the dates of monthly vapor leak inspections conducted with the use of a halogenated hydrocarbon detector.	On April 15, 2009 during a facility inspection the operator at this facility did not keep a log of the halogen leak detector monthly checks of the dry cleaning equipment.

The above violation(s) may subject the violator to **penalties** of up to \$25,000 per violation. It is possible that a penalty will be assessed in this case. If a penalty is to be assessed, the amount will be determined after your response is reviewed.

### Required Actions

Within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this Notice of Violation, the permittee shall:

1. Abate the violations or provide for an acceptable remedy.
2. Reply in writing to this Notice of Violation within fourteen (14) days of receipt. The reply shall include:
  - a. descriptions and dates of actions taken thus far to abate the violation(s);
  - b. descriptions and expeditious time schedule of actions yet to be taken to remedy the violation(s); and
  - c. descriptions of actions taken or to be taken to prevent recurrence of the violation(s).

### Recommended Remedial Actions

It is recommended that you consider the following suggestions:

- Implement all monitoring, recordkeeping, reporting and testing requirements of the Permit-to-Install and Operate at Campus Cleaners.
- Implement the additional requirements of the amended MACT, 40 CFR 63, subpart M, in particular Part 63.322(o).
- Use the halogenated hydrocarbon detector at least once a month and count as one of the weekly visual inspections.
