On 8/3/10, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requesting that United Dairy Farmers #325 conduct annual Stage II testing then submit the test results for the Air-to-Liquid Ratio and Static Leak testing along with a copy of the Stage II Compliance Specialist Training. CDAQ is in receipt of a test results for the Air-to-Liquid Ratio and Static Leak testing dated 8/25/10. You are expected to comply with submitting a copy of the Stage II Compliance Specialist Training by 10/15/10. Failure to do so may result in referral to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. Fulfillment of your commitments included in the corrective action plan and/or any modifications contained within this letter does not constitute a waiver of CDAQ's ability to refer this matter to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
