

NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to obtain a state operating permit; Failure to provide proof of attendance and completion of training required by Ohio EPA

Dear Mr. Shah:

On March 11, 2010, and May 10, 2010, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Letter of Warning requesting that Lakeland Sunoco submit proof of attendance and completion of training for a Stage II compliance specialist certificate within thirty (30) days of receipt of the letter. Lakeland Sunoco has failed to provide proof of attendance and completion of training required by Ohio EPA. This is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD)(3)(a)(vi).

Upon further investigation, CDAQ found that Lakeland Sunoco has been operating a gasoline dispensing facility without obtaining a current PTIO permit or submitting a Permit-by-Rule (PBR) Notification form since December 28, 2005. This is a violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05 (G) and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-31-02(A).

Lakeland Sunoco remains in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Lakeland Sunoco submit either a PTIO application or a Permit-by-Rule Notification form and also submit proof of attendance and completion of training for a Stage II compliance specialist certificate to the following enforcement representative within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this letter:

If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, a written response which includes a timeline for correcting the alleged violations must be received within fourteen (14) days of this letter.



Also, your facility may be eligible for the Permit-by-Rule (PBR) exemption. This exemption is based on monthly and annual throughput amounts.

Please review the PBR Requirements for gasoline dispensing facilities to determine if your gasoline dispensing facility meets the criteria for this exemption.

Please note that all PBR Notification forms submitted to CDAQ must include original signatures. Photocopied signatures are not valid; the PBR Notification form will not be accepted by CDAQ and will be returned to you if original signatures are not provided.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
