Southwest Ohio Air Quality Agency has concluded that Cincinnati Color Press, Inc. did not complete stack testing in accordance with section E.11. of the Permit to Operate issued on January 4, 2007, for emissions units R001, R002, R003, R004 and R005. Please find the Intent to Test form enclosed. Upon further investigation, our agency has found that Cincinnati Color Press, Inc. has not submitted quarterly deviation reports in accordance with section D.1. of the Permit to Operate issued on 1/4/07 for emissions units R001, R002, R003, R004 and R005 for the second, third and fourth quarter of 2011. Furthermore, the current Permits to Operate for emissions units R001, R002, R003, R004 and R005 have expired on January 4, 2012. Please find the application for renewal Permits to Operate enclosed.

In order to address these compliance deficiencies, please submit the following compliance plan and schedule for each of the aforementioned emissions units within 30 days of receipt of this letter. Submit this plan to the attention of Kerri Castlen.
