Dear Mr. Murphy:

The purpose of this letter is to notify your company of violations of the air permits issued for the Good Wood Inc. facility located at 42591 Bina Road in Belmont, Ohio that were discovered during a recent review of the facility file, and to request correction of these violations. Permits applicable to this facility include permit-to-install (PTI) #17-1296 issued on September 29, 1994, and permits-to-operate (PTOs) issued on May 29, 1997. These operating permits are still effective as they were extended upon receipt of renewal applications on April 25, 2000.

As we discussed during a telephone conversation on June 26, 2006, the company had failed to submit the annual reports that are due by February 15 of each year for each of the four permitted emissions units at this facility (F001 – roadways and parking; F002 – sawdust storage; P001 – woodworking system #1; and P002 – woodworking system #2). On June 27, 2006, a report was received for emissions units P001 and P002 for calendar years 1997 through 2005, but no reports were received for emissions units F001 and F002. During our call, you indicated that you had shut down the sawmill, and that the roadways and parking areas have little to no use. However, a request to remove emissions unit F002 and revoke the permit for the roadways and parking areas (F001), which may be considered de Minimis under Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-15-05, was never received.

The continuing reporting violations were discussed with Chuck Lewis on July 14, 2008. On December 9, 2008, the Southeast District Office (SEDO) of Ohio EPA received a compliance report for calendar years 2006 and 2007 for this facility. This report was originally submitted with the non-Title V fee emission report that was received by the Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) in Ohio EPA's Central Office on May 7, 2008, and only covered emissions units P001 and P002. Both reports were late because they were not submitted to Ohio EPA by February 15 of each year. In addition, Good Wood Inc. remains in violation of Part II.D.1 of the PTOs for each of the four emissions units for failing to provide annual reports for calendar year 2008.

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To resolve these reporting violations, please provide the required annual report for 2008 for each of the four permitted emissions units, as well as reports for emissions units F001 and F002 from 1997 through present. If the company no longer stores sawdust in a trailer (emissions unit F002), please request that this emissions unit be shut down and provide SEDO with a shutdown date. If Good Wood Inc. believes its roadways and parking areas are no longer subject to Ohio's air pollution regulations, please provide SEDO with the company's potential-to-emit (PTE) calculations and request revocation of the permits for emissions unit F001 if applicable. However, if the PTO still needs to be renewed, please provide this office with a copy of the renewal application as the version in SEDO's files is incomplete. ***Please provide the overdue reports and other requested information within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this letter.***

In addition, please be advised that pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) § 3704.03(G), Ohio EPA cannot renew the operating permits for this facility unless there is a showing satisfactory to the director or the director's representative that the air contaminant sources are being operated in compliance with applicable emission standards and other rules. Therefore, Ohio EPA cannot renew your company's operating permits until you achieve compliance with the reporting requirements in the existing permits for this facility.
